Gary E. Nuse, 68, of Eaton, OH, passed away suddenly on Wednesday night October 28, 2015. Born March 31, 1947, he was a son of the late Dale E. Nuse, Sr. & Helen (Bunger) Nuse. He was a US Army veteran of the Vietnam War and retired from the Shipping Department of Parker Hannifin in Eaton after 27 years. Gary was an active member of the Old Farts Car Club and enjoyed taking his 1951 Ford Truck to car shows. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by brother Dale E. "Butch" Nuse, Jr. and infant brother James Nuse.
